



Dear Parent, Guardian & Carers,

The health and wellbeing of our students and staff is paramount. We have therefore decided to suspend the face to face delivery of the majority of learning and teaching from Monday 23rd March 2020 to help reduce the risk of spread of coronavirus within our community. This is the current advice we are working towards, but as Government announcements are made, this may change.

This suspension will cover all classroom taught courses. Students should therefore not attend any onsite classes (tutorials, laboratory classes, practical workshops, etc.) until notified otherwise, however learning will continue.

Next steps

Our planning is well advanced for this outcome and next week (Monday 23rd March) will be a self-study week for transition as we finalise, publish and implement our plans for online delivery and assessment to ensure we maintain the highest possible quality of education to our students at this unprecedented time.

Each of our Faculties will be in contact with their students over the week to provide subject-specific information about the new teaching and assessment arrangements being put in place.

Clearly, this is a rapidly developing situation and so the College will continue to follow Government and NHS guidance. As and when there are further changes to our operations and activities, we will update you as soon as possible.
